
Here's how to track your summer reading progress:

- 1. To log your child's reading information, go to http://sppl.readsquared.com/
- 2. Click Login in the upper right-hand corner and enter the username and password you just created.



3. Once you're logged in go to the upper left hand corner of the page and select the family member whose reading information you'd like to track.




4. You'll then be taken to their home page which will track their progress over the course of the summer. You'll have an opportunity to win up to 100 points.

If your child is reading picture books, each picture book is worth 1 point. If your child is reading chapter books each book is worth 5 points. Children enrolled in

our Chapter Book program can also earn points by writing book reviews and attending programs.


You'll be eligible to win prizes once you hit the 25, 50 and 100-point mark.



5. In order to track your reading, click the "**Log Reading**" button, located under your point total.

6. It will then ask you to enter the name of the book you've just read. Entering the author's name is optional. Then select the name of the child who finished the book. You can select multiple children for the same book, as well.




Then click "Submit" in the bottom left hand corner.


Once you've submitted your reading information, your dashboard will be updated accordingly.

Children in the Chapter Book Program can earn additional points by writing book reviews. **Each book review is worth 5 points.**


In order to review a book, select "Review Book" from the main menu




And then enter your review. Each review must be a minimum of 250 characters long (Approximately 3 sentences).



Your points will update once you submit your review:



Readers in the Chapter Book Program will also have the ability to earn points by attending special book-themed events throughout the summer. At these programs a secret code will be given out. After the program, participants can redeem the code for points by clicking "ENTER CODE" on the main menu. Type in the event code and then click "Submit".



Points will automatically update once they've been submitted.

Once you hit the 25, 50 and 100 point marks you will be eligible for various prizes. As always weekly prizes will also be available in addition to the point prize. A paper booklet to track weekly prizes and books read will also be available in the library, if you'd like to use that in addition to the ReadSquared portal.
