

Here's how to log your summer reading progress:

To log your child's reading information, go to http://sppl.readsquared.com/

Click **Login** in the upper righthand corner and enter the username and password you just created.



Once you're logged in go to the upper left hand corner of the page and select the family member whose reading information you'd like to track.




You'll then be taken to their home page which will track their progress over the course of the summer. You'll have an opportunity to win up to 100 points.

- If your child is reading picture books, each picture book is worth 1 point.
- If your child is reading chapter books each page is worth .05 points.
- You'll be eligible to win prizes once you hit the 25, 50 and 100 point mark.

You can also come into the library each week to pick up a new prize EACH WEEK regardless of how many points you've earned.

In order to track your reading, click the "Log" button, located under your point total.



If you are in the Picture Book Program It will then ask you to enter the name of the book you've just read. Entering the author's name is optional. Then select the name of the child who finished the book. You can select multiple children for the same book, as well.
