

ABOUT US

The Middlesex County Area Transit Program, the passenger transportation division of the Middlesex County Department of Community Services, Office of Aging and Disabled Services, provides transportation for senior citizens, persons with disabilities and the general public.

ADVANCE RESERVATION BASED SERVICE

MCAT provides transportation with a fee of \$3.00 per trip (one way), to seniors 60+ and disabled residents of Middlesex County. The general purpose of the program is to make intermittent transportation available and accessible so that residents may obtain the necessities of life, with priority given to non-emergency medical services. Advanced registration, reservation and pre-purchase of tickets are required.

TRANSPORTATION PARAMETERS

- Individuals must have a scheduled appointment in order to register and reserve transportation.
- Tickets must be pre-purchased in advance of transportation.
- Reservations can be made no earlier than fourteen (14) calendar days and no less than three (3) full business days before your appointment.
- Transportation is a shared ride with other passengers.
- Transportation is curb-to-curb. Drivers are not permitted to assist passengers beyond the curb.
- Transportation is provided within Middlesex County and up to 5 miles outside the County.
- Dialysis transportation is provided to Middlesex County locations only.
- Requests for service will be met as resources permit.

VETERANS' TRANSPORTATION PARAMETERS

- Veterans' transportation is available twice a week to Lyons Hospital on Tuesdays and Thursdays.
- Veterans' transportation is available three times a week to East Orange Hospital on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays.
- Veterans' transportation is available Monday through Friday to medical facilities within Middlesex County.

MIDDLESEX COUNTY COMMUNITY SHUTTLE PROGRAM

Provides scheduled services, which do not require advance reservation, for the general public. The routes offer a 30 or 60 minute frequency of service, Monday through Friday, are wheelchair accessible and offer connections to NJ Transit bus and rail services.
