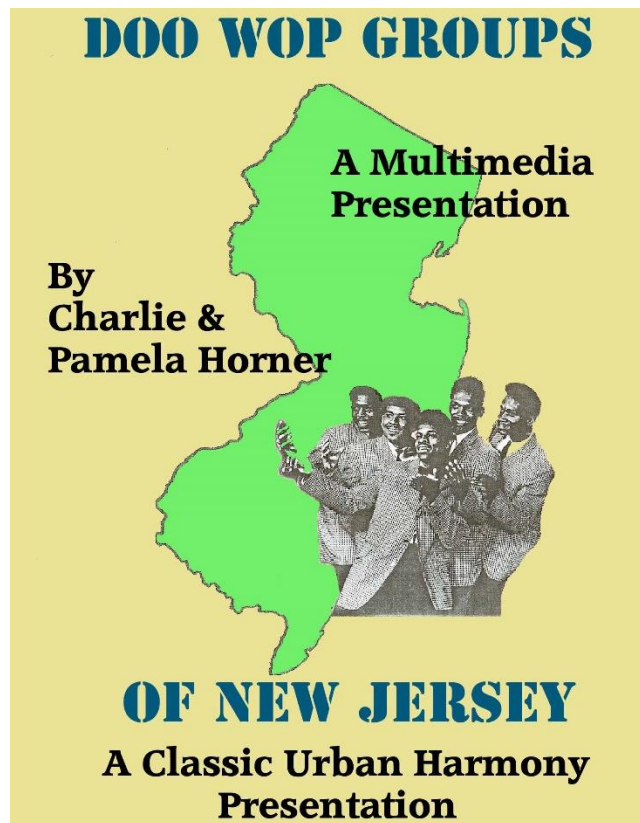


Doo Wop Groups of NJ:



New Jersey produced more than its share of great doo wop groups. From the pre-Four Seasons groups mentioned in "Jersey Boys" to the Duprees, Monotones, Rivas and Shirelles, you'll hear fascinating stories about the doo wop music scene of 1950's Newark, Plainfield, Jersey City, Asbury Park and other cities in the Garden State.

- Hear how the Duprees got their name and listen to a rare tape they made before they ever recorded "You Belong To Me",
- Follow the real story of Frankie Valli & the Jersey Boys as the Four Lovers.
- Learn how a toothpaste commercial and an errant baseball led to the Monotones writing "The Book of Love".
- Find out which groups' career was cut short by a tragic fire and hear about groups like the Del Larks, Vibranaires, the Hi-Fives and Ronnie & the Hi-Lites

Doo Wop historians Charlie & Pamela Horner's multimedia presentation will cover doo wop groups from the Garden State! On exhibit will be photos of more than 50 doo wop groups from NJ. There'll be captivating stories, photos from the Classic Urban Harmony Archives of records, photographs, sheet music and memorabilia, and plenty of music and video clips for to sing along with.
