Natural and manmade catastrophes can strike quickly, with little or no warning and with devastating results. Whether is disaster is a natural occurrence, such as Hurricane Katrina, or a manmade catastrophe, such as the events of Sept. 11, 2001, history has shown us that the first response to a calamity is absolutely vital.

The First Responders Directory, created by the Rutgers Citizenship and Service Education Initiative and the Allstate Foundation, was designed to augment the communications resources of Garden State law enforcement and public safety community, the first responders to any natural or manmade disaster. The pocket-size booklets serve as a statewide database of all first responder units in New Jersey. The initiative, based on the Ne Brunswick campus of Rutgers University, is distributing the First Responders Directory. The booklets were provided to the New Jersey Office of Emergency Management, which in turn distributed the directories at training for FEMA professional development certi-

These booklets are also being provided to the Conference Campus Community Partnerships at Montclair State University; the Linda Rivera Learn and Serve - Youth Organized for Disaster Preparedness program; and emergency management offices in Middlesex County. The database can be accessed at frd.case.rutgers.edu.

# : Valley gets golf award



# **Makeover continues** at The Bernards Inn

BERNARDSVILLE — The floor boards still creak and the hallway floor is still slanted, but with the renovation The Bernards Inn, most of the rest of the structure has been or will be refreshed as part of an ongoing renovation project.

The Inn, circa 1907, was purchased by Hampshire Real Estate Companies last April and its award winning restaurant, lobby area, banquet facilities and 20 guest rooms are receiving a facelift. Meanwhile, the inn and its restaurant remain open and ready to serve visitors and hungry patrons.

"We feel like this is a big mansion," said owner Harold Imperatore. "The lobby, we call our front hall. The bar is the library and a dining area is the conservatory. We treat this like a home that people want to return to."

Work on the multi-phased renovation and restoration project started in May, with the lobby, conservatory, library and the much of the exterior already


"It's not a house that was converted to an inn, but it has that feeling," said Jeffrey Hanson, executive vice president of Hampshire Real Estate

In the lobby, the dark forest green walls have been replaced by cream wall coverings and light green accents are bathed in sunlight from the large

"We wanted a warm, welcoming feeling," Imperatore said. "Everything was so dark before. It had a tired feeling."

Previously, dark colored paint and deep woodworked masked most of the beauty of the inn.

"It needed a facelift," Imperatore said. "We wanted to make a good investment into the property."

The conservatory, with its black and white checkered flooring, mossy green paneling and over-sized windows with shutters, resembles a breezy and relaxed outdoor porch café.
"We removed so much ceil-

plaster Imperatore said. "We took out the carpeting and got all new furniture and lighting."

So far, nine of the 20 guest rooms have been renovated and also feature warm twotoned neutral colors comple-

mented by cozy pastel linens, soft carpets and furnishings. One of the rooms' most inviting touches includes the thick drapes that frame the lofted four poster beds. All renovation work has been done by Jeffrey Haines of Butler's of Far Hills. "Each room will have the

same themes, but they won't be cookie cutter rooms," Imperatore said. "They'll all be different and have their own personality."

The rooms each feature flat screen televisions that can be hidden away in large natural wood consoles. By the end of the year, three more rooms and one banquet room should be completed.

Phase three, scheduled for this month will bring the renovation the Great Room, a banquet room on the main level that is now cloaked in dark colors with heavy burgundy drapes and dark wood work. Renovation work is expected to take two to three weeks. The already renovated bar area, or the library, provides a glimpse of what the Great Room could become. In the library, the gold tones and textured finishes highlight

"We're told on the lower level there's a fire place hidden behind one of the walls," Imperatore said. "We're excited to see that.'

The \$1.5 million renovation and restoration project is scheduled to be complete within two years. In keeping the establishment open during the process, crews must work around banquets, guests and the restaurant operations.

While renovation work is commencing, Chef Corey Heyer has continued to whip up tasty meals in the kitchen. Heyer has been with the inn for just under three years and was trained at the Culinary Institute of America.

"We're always changing the menu or adding things according to the seasons," Heyer said as he cut fresh halibut. "In the summer, we focus a lot on seafood and now we're getting into the game season with venison, pheasant and rab-

A continual favorite is the creamy lobster bisque soup, but Hanson is partial to the chicken salad.

"It's a non-mayo chicken salad with horseradish sauce," he said. "It's incredible."

There are at least three new dished added to the extensive menu every six weeks, Heyer

The renovation project is an encouraging investment into the restaurant.

"It's uplifting," Heyer said. "It motivates you to want to be your best.'

One the beverage side, Sommelier Terri Baldwin offers patrons from a list of more than 14,000 bottles of wine in 1,000 selections.

"I love being able to have the opportunity where I can educate and excite people about what they're drinking," she said. "And the renovation shows a dedication to the cus-
